Saving Designs from Your PC


1. Connection to Your PC

You can import designs stored in your PC and save them in the machine memory.



- This operation requires you to install DG by Pulse (optional design creation software) on your PC. For more information, refer to the user's manual for DG by Pulse.

1-1. How to connect the machine to your PC



- To connect the machine via a router to your PC, use a straight cable available on the market.



- 1 Turn OFF the PC, router, and machine and connect the LAN between the PC and machine.

- 2 Turn ON the router.
- 3 Turn ON the PC and start "DG by Pulse".
- 4 Turn ON the machine.

- 5 Press  on the main screen.




- To use this feature, enter the password to set the functional limit level to "SEL".




- 6 Press .
- 7 Select "78. Optional device (software)".

- 8 Press .



9 To select "1. Network".

10 Press  .



11 Press   next to "Network" and select "Normal".


12 Press   next to "IP address" and select "Auto".

13 Press  .

Various addresses are automatically acquired.



- If automatic acquisition fails, check the LAN cable connection, operating steps, and the settings of DG by Pulse.



14 Press  .

The machine and PC are connected.
